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Notes:

MDI = Metered Dose Inhaler. DPI = Dry Powder Inhaler. B/A = Breath Actuated. QM = Quick Mist

* Qvar has extrafine particles and is twice as potent as Clenil Modulite
Therefore: Qvar 100mcg is equivalent to Beclometasone (Clenil) 200mcg
